RESOUND FAMILY OF CHURCHES

GraceCity Church is located in the city of Nagoya, a manufacturing and shipping hub that has interestingly been referred to as “a place people don’t want to visit.” A survey was conducted among residents of eight Japanese cities to determine which were the most appealing as travel destinations. Nagoya came in last in almost every category, and was chosen only as the third favourite by its own residents.



According to **Damian Grateley**, who pastors GraceCity, residents of Nagoya are often perceived as being insecure and passive. But it is his hope that the gospel will bring a renewed sense of identity and freedom to this city, allowing people to be more vulnerable with one another.

GraceCity’s congregation has a mixture of local and international attendees, worshipping and fellowshiping in both Japanese and English. It has recently celebrated its 10th anniversary, and is 18-months into a revitalisation project.
