Dear Parent:

Today's Bible Time story told of four determined men who knew Jesus could heal their friend. They didn't let anything stop them—the long walk carrying the sick man, the crowd of people, or even the roof! Jesus knew their hearts and saw their faith. Before Jesus healed the paralytic, he forgave his sins. Christ went beyond what they asked.

Today, we talked about what it means to be paralyzed. We said our verse together and talked about how we love God because he first loved us. We also talked about sin and how it does not please God. Explain to your children what sin is and encourage them to tell God "I'm sorry, forgive me when I sin." Teach your children while they are young to live for God. Christ will lovingly answer beyond what you ask.
